2010 MIDTERM ELECTION POLLING: WAVES 4 AND 5

-- FINAL TOPLINE --

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Note: Q.2c, 8, 10, 11 and 15-17 should be cited as a *USA Today/Gallup* poll.

Results are based on telephone interviews conducted October 14-17 and October 21-24, 2010, with a random sample of 3,051—adults, aged 18+, living in the continental U.S., selected using random-digit dial sampling.

For results based on the total sample of national adults, one can say with 95% confidence that the margin of error is ±2 percentage points.

For results based on the sample of 2,746-- registered voters, the maximum margin of sampling error is ±2 percentage points.
