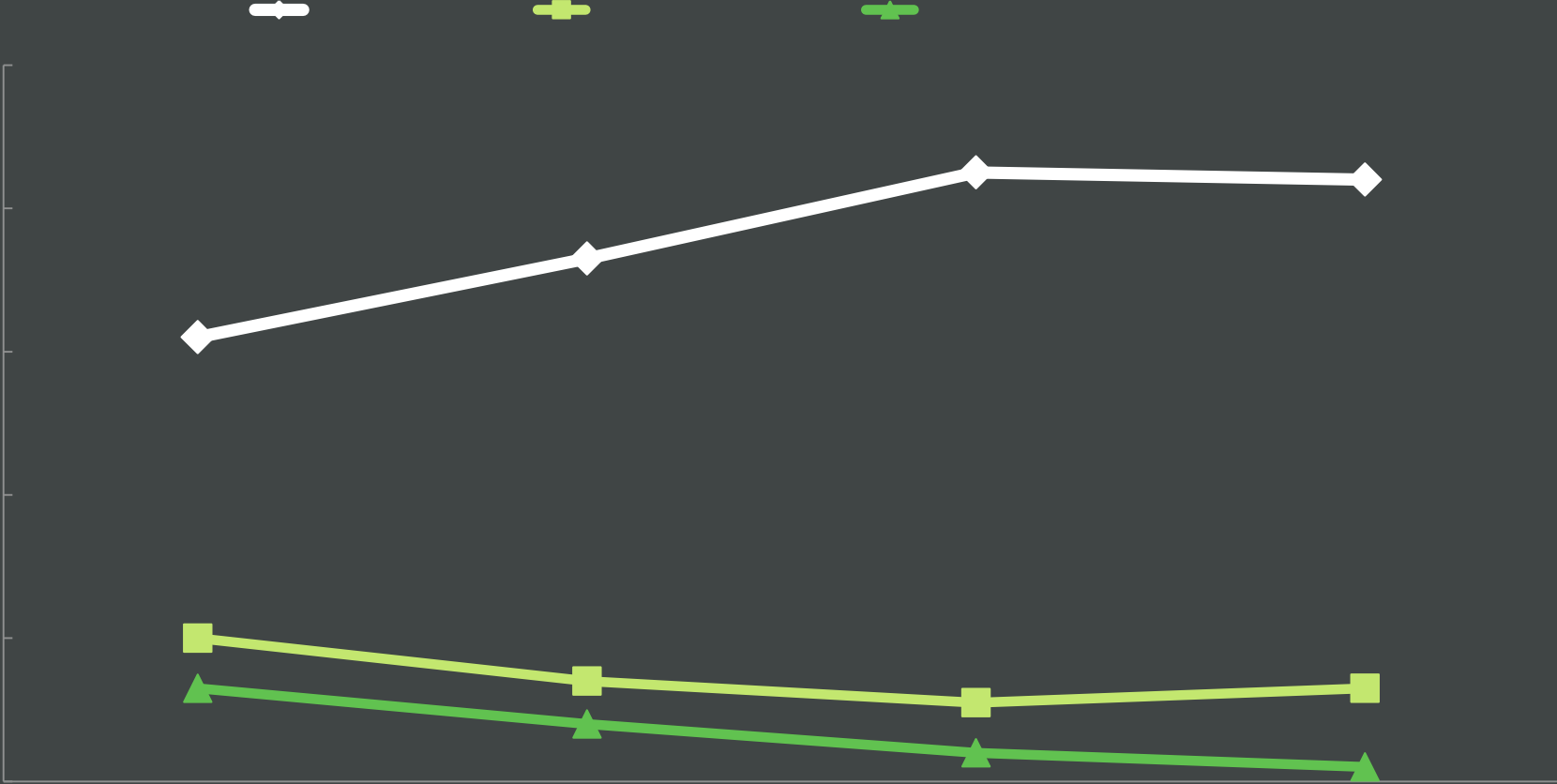

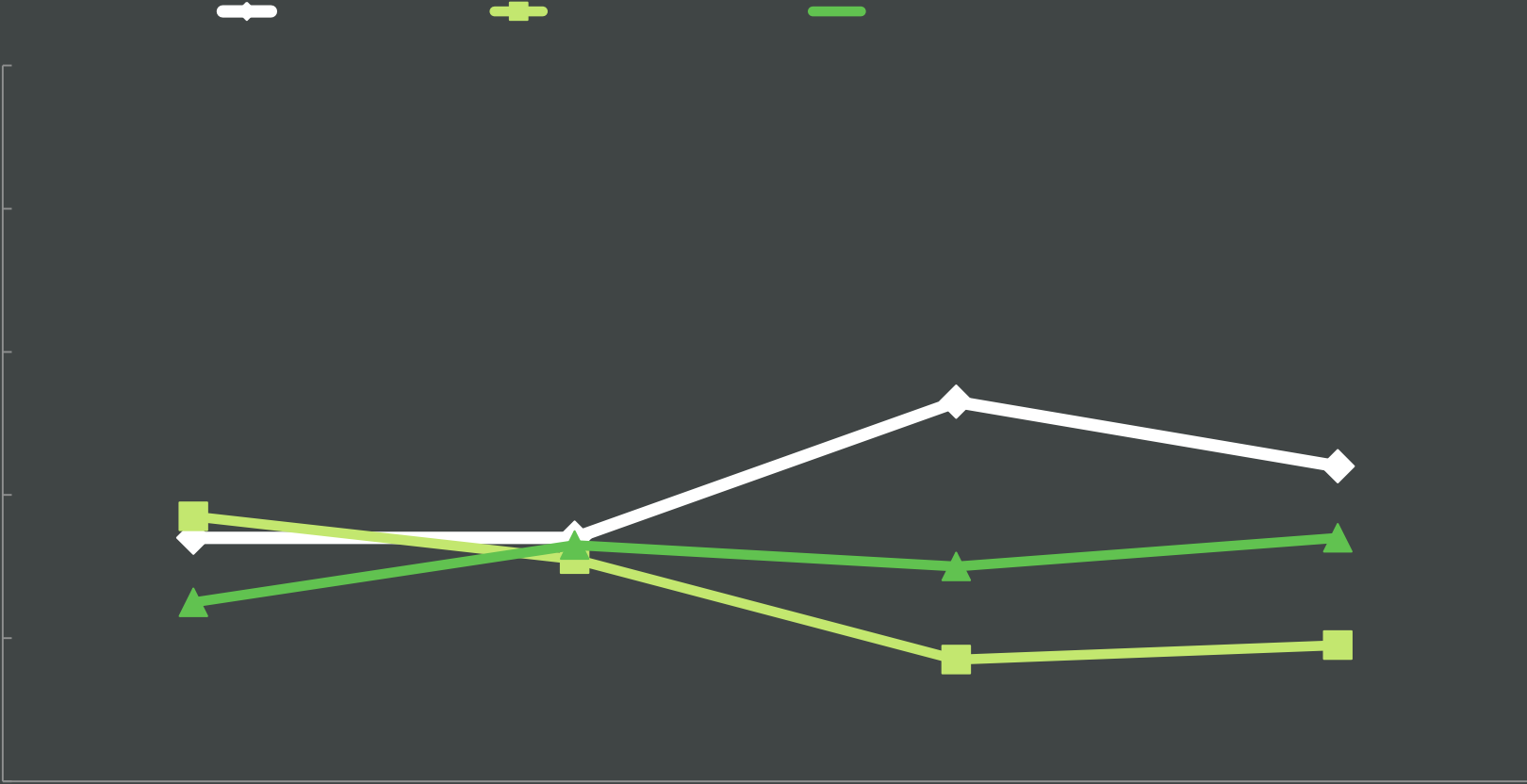

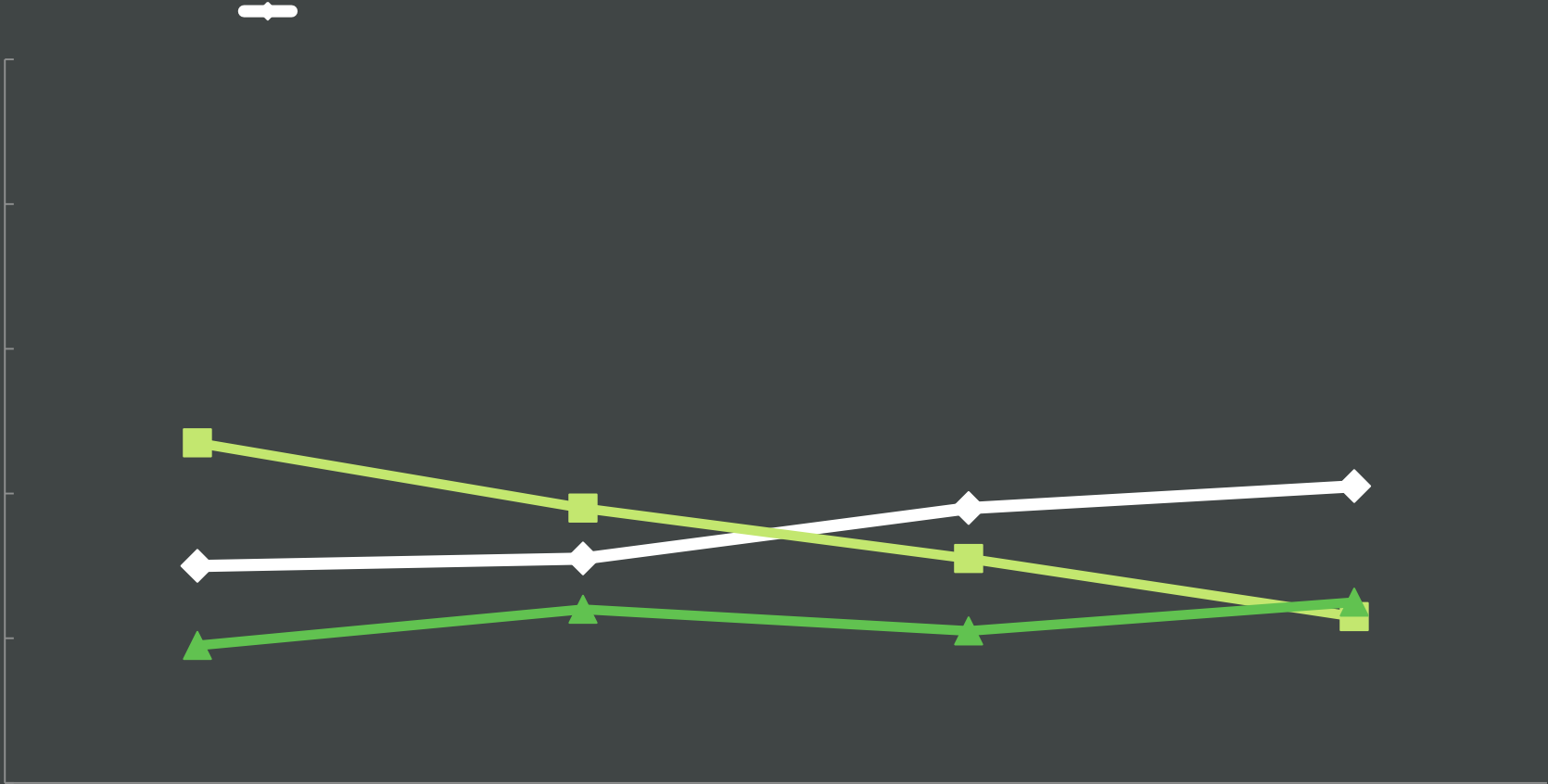

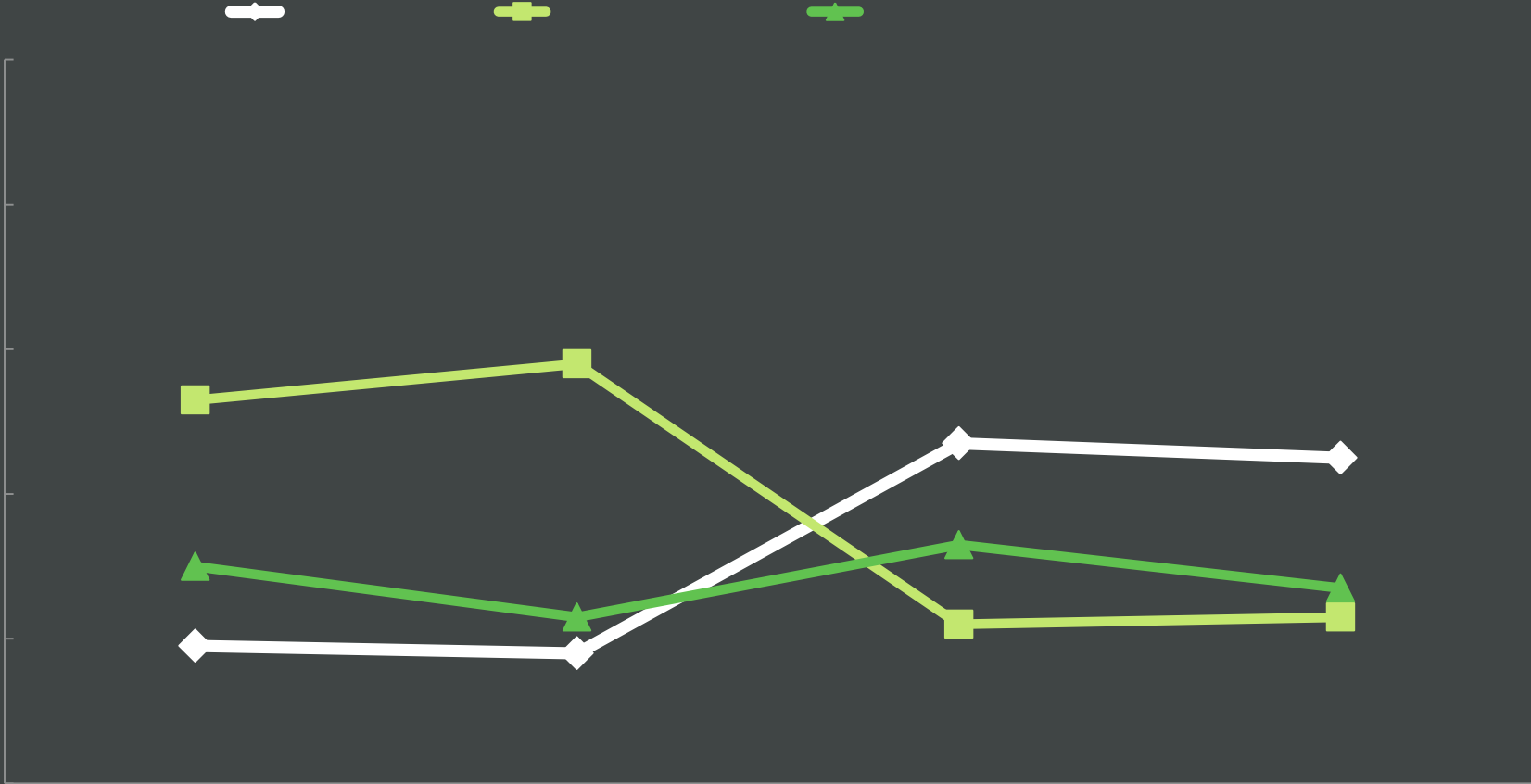

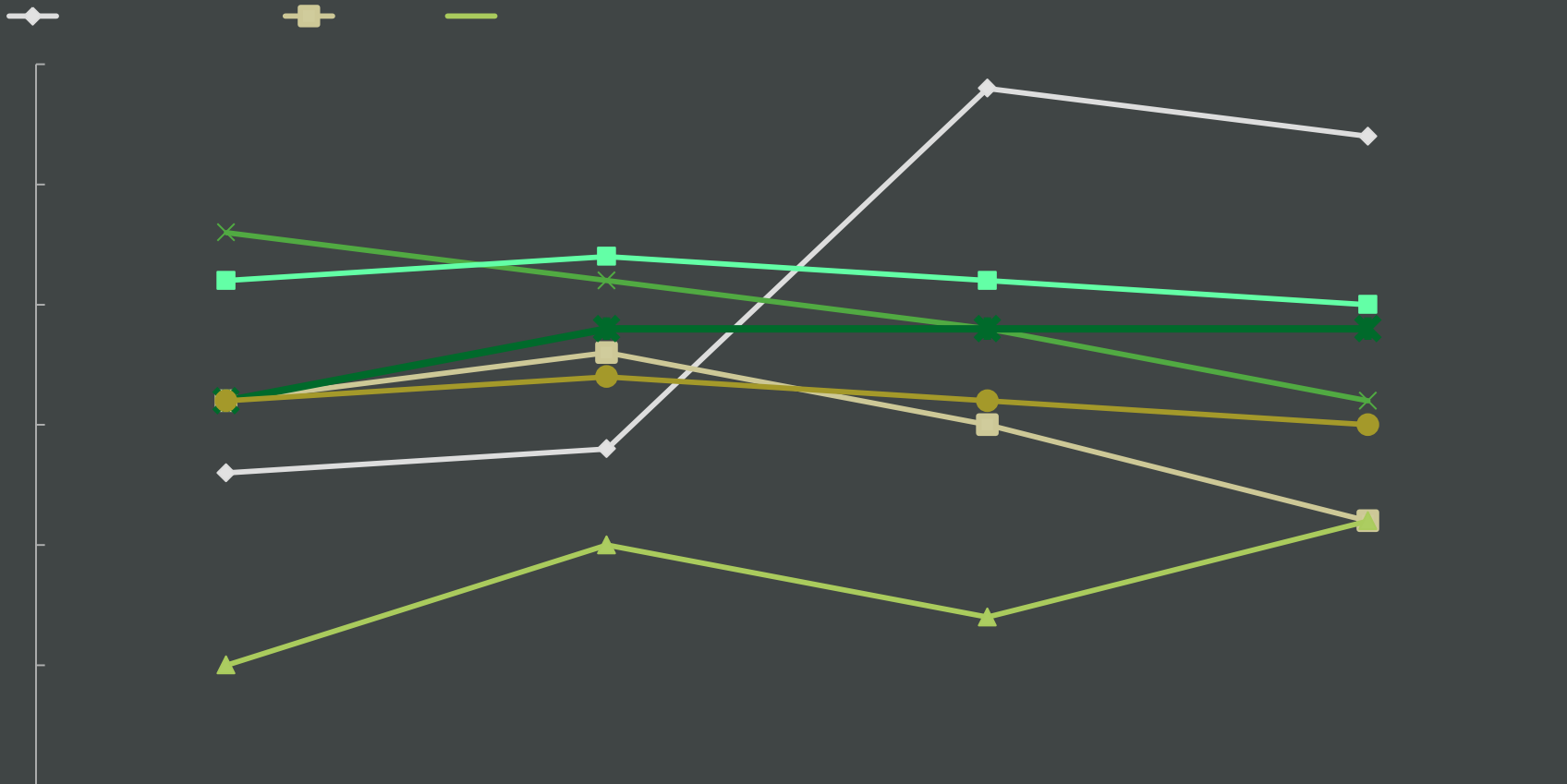

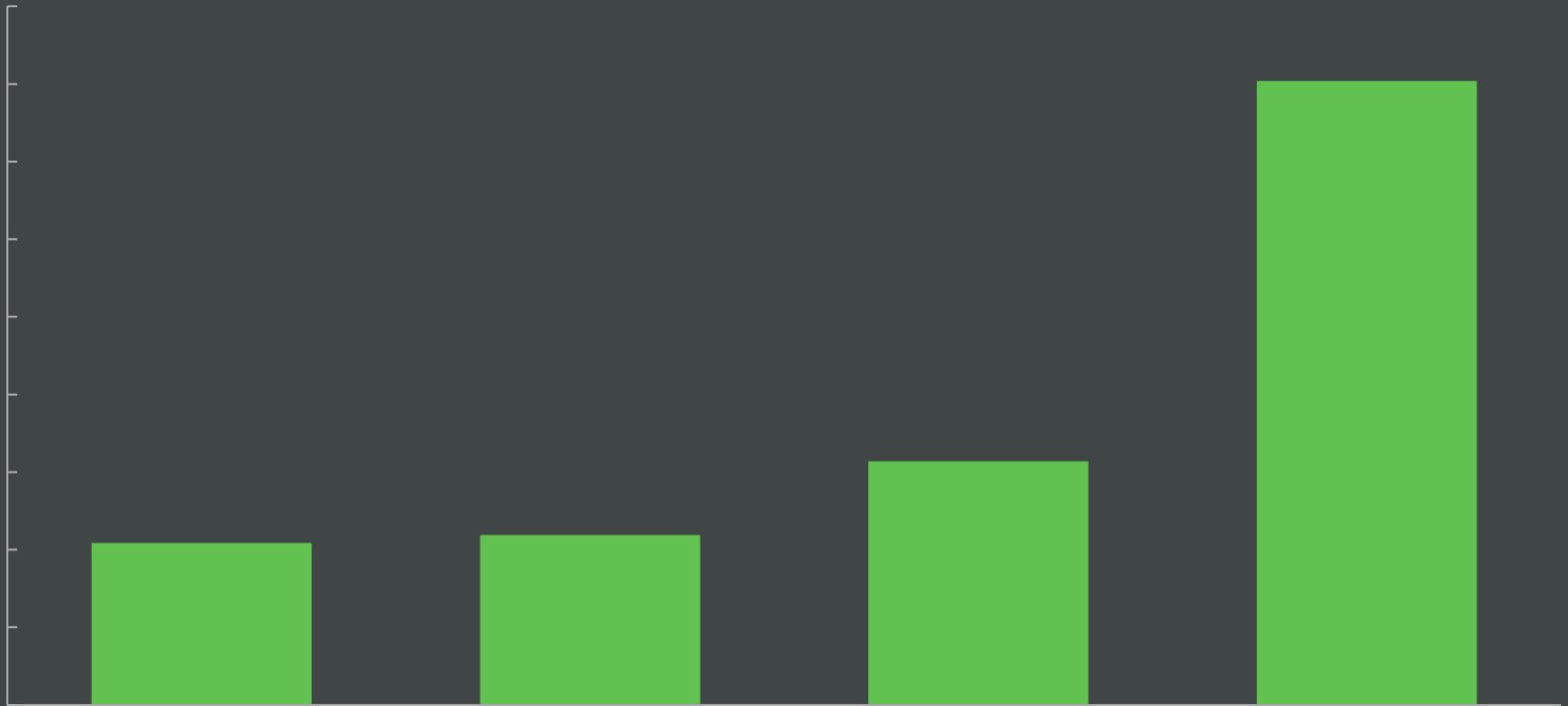

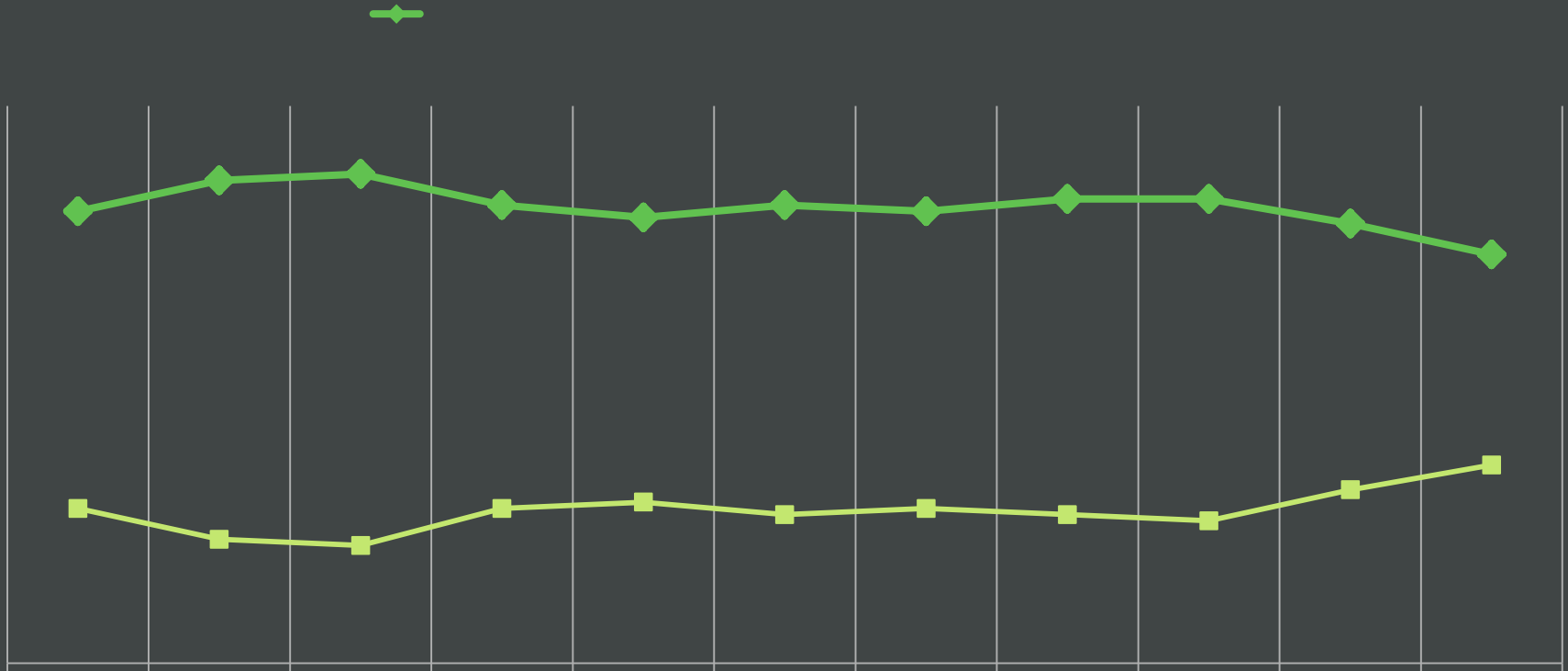
# U.S. Attitudes Toward Egypt
