EXECUTIVE ACTIONS ON IMMIGRATION

Results are based on telephone interviews with a random sample of --6,084-- national adults, aged 18+, living in all 50 states and the District of Columbia, conducted November 24-December 7, 2014. For results based on the total sample of National Adults, the margin of error is ± 2 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of --4,539-- non-Hispanic whites, the margin of error is ± 2 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of --553-- non-Hispanic blacks, the margin of error is ± 5 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of --584-- Hispanics, the margin of error is ± 5 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of --574-- immigrants (those born outside the U.S.), the margin of error is ± 5 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

Interviews are conducted with respondents on landline telephones and cellular phones, with interviews conducted in Spanish for respondents who are primarily Spanish-speaking. Each sample of national adults includes a minimum quota of 50% cell phone respondents and 50% landline respondents, with additional minimum quotas by time zone within region. Landline and cell phone numbers are selected using random digit dial methods. Landline respondents are chosen at random within each household on the basis of which
